

BERC TRACK 1 PROJECTS – 2010

Track 1 projects are projects that are screened by the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (VFPA), and referred to the BERC for comment.

Through considerable discussion between the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority and the agencies of the BERC (Fisheries and Oceans Canada, Ministry of Environment and Transport Canada), all the participants have agreed to the following criteria:

- Guidelines/Best Management Practices (BMP's) are in place
- Damage to habitat (fish, wildlife, etc.) are unlikely
- Adverse effects (environmental and related economic/social) are unlikely
- There is lower public interest
- Listed track 1 project

2010 Project List

- **2010-01-B001 Seaspan International Ltd. (Seaspan)** is proposing to install a sewage hook-up between existing sewage tanks on Pier 94 in North Vancouver and an existing sewage line located on the upland of the site. Recd by BERC Jan 5/10.
- **2010-02-B002 -Canadian Coast Guard – Pacific Region** is planning to install three new aids to navigation in the Second Narrows area and one set of sector lights on the Second Narrows rail bridge. Recd BERC Feb 9/10.
- **2010-02-B003 - Keystone Environmental Ltd. (Keystone)** is proposing to conduct maintenance dredging at the Rocky Point boat channel and float area in Port Moody. Recd by BERC Feb 10/10. Authorization sent by VFPA Feb 17/10. Feb 24/10 – DFO reported that more sediment sampling is being undertaken but extension into Fisheries Sensitive Period will not be granted.
- **2010-02-B004 – Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (VFPA)** is proposing to reinstall a debris containment boom in Burrard Inlet, North Shore. The previous containment boom was removed in Fall 2009 as it had reached the end of its service life. Recd by BERC Feb 23/10.
- **2010- 02- B005 - Canadian Coast Guard – Pacific Region** is planning to install a new navigation range on the west side of Port Moody (in the vicinity of Carroholly Point). Recd by BERC Feb 24/10.
- **2010-03-B006 - The Ministry of Transportation & Infrastructure** is proposing to conduct maintenance painting on the Ironworker's Memorial Second Narrows Bridge. Recd by BERC Mar 8/10.
- **2010-03-B007 - Port Metro Vancouver** is proposing to conduct timber fender pile repairs at the Main Street Dock in Vancouver, BC. Recd by BERC Mar 16/10.
- **2010-03-B008 - Keystone Environmental, on behalf of Seaspan International Ltd.,** is proposing to conduct a geotechnical and environmental investigation and sampling program at Vancouver Shipyards in North Vancouver, BC.
- **2010-03-B009 - WorleyParsons Westmar (Westmar)** is proposing to conduct repairs to the Shellburn Terminal treated timber wharf located in Burnaby, BC. Recd by BERC Mar 24/10.
- **2010-03-B010 - Randy Worms and Colleen Pollock** are proposing to demolish and remove a storage shed located partially on VFPA property and partially on their private property in Port Moody, BC. Recd by BERC Mar 31/10.

- **2010-05-B011 - Silverbirch Management Ltd. (Silverbirch)** is proposing to remove a concrete pier abutment from the former Cannery Restaurant facility as part of their lease exit requirements. Recd by BERC May 4/10.
- **2010-05-B012 - Golder Associates'** proposal, on behalf of both **Seaspan International and Domtar Inc.**, to conduct soil and sediment quality investigations at and adjacent to the Vancouver Shipyards facility in North Vancouver, BC. Recd by BERC May 26/10.
- **2010-05-B013 - Telus'** proposal to remove redundant submerged cable from Port Moody Arm. Recd by BERC May 27/10.
- **2010-06-B014 - BC Hydro's** proposes to conduct repairs to an offshore hydraulic tank at the Burrard Generating Station in Port Moody, BC. Recd by ERC June 8/10.
- **2010-06-B015 - Village of Belcarra's** proposal to establish a Habitat Protection Zone for eelgrass within Bedwell Bay, including the installation of two marine buoys anchored with 100 lb concrete blocks, and the installation of two upland signs. Recd by BERC June 22/10.
- **2010-07-B016** – URS on behalf of Chevron proposes to conduct a sediment sampling along the foreshore at the Chevron Refinery in Burnaby BC. Sediment samples will be collected by hand held sampling equipment from 44 locations along the foreshore, centred around an area where visible NAPL seeps were identified in April 2010. Recd by BERC July 5/10. Minor amendment forwarded July 12/10.
- **2010-07-B017** – Proposal by Trojan Technologies to conduct a test of a ballast water treatment system at Main Street Dock, Vancouver, BC. Recd by ERC Jul 6/10.
- **2010-07-B018 - Fraser River Pile & Dredge (FRPD),** on behalf of Fibreco Export Inc., is proposing to conduct maintenance dredging at the barge ramp at the Fibreco facility in North Vancouver. Recd July 7/10.
- **2010-07-B019 - BC Hydro** propose to conduct maintenance on four cathodic protection rectifiers located on an offshore platform at the Burrard Generating Station in Port Moody, BC. Recd by BERC July 12/10.
- **2010-07-B020 - VFPA's** proposes to replace a collapsed culvert at Berry Point. Recd by BERC July 12/10.
- **2010-7-B021 - Keystone Environmental (Keystone),** on behalf of Seaspan, and working under a BC Ministry of Environment remediation order, proposes to conduct environmental drilling at five (5) locations at the foot of Pemberton Avenue adjacent to the west of the Vancouver Shipyards, North Vancouver, BC. Recd by ERC July 30/10.
- **2010-08-B022 - Arcadis Canada,** on behalf of Kinder Morgan Canada Terminals, proposes to conduct a sediment and pore water sampling program within the subtidal zone adjacent to the Kinder Morgan Vancouver Wharves facility located in North Vancouver, BC. Recd by ERC Aug 9/10.
- **2010-08-B023 - VFPA** project to conduct repairs on the Main Street Dock in Vancouver, BC. Recd by BERC Aug 31/10.
- **2010-09-B024 - FWS Western Ltd.,** on behalf of Cargill Ltd., are proposing to conduct a grain-handling conveyor upgrade program at the Cargill Ltd. facility located at 801 Low Level Road, North Vancouver, BC. Recd by BERC Sep 23/10. Sep 28/10 - Section 10 approval under the NWPA reqd.

- **2010-09-B025** - Jellystone Films Inc. proposes to film stunt sequences for Final Destination 5 at Berry Point, Burnaby, BC. Recd by BERC Sep 23/10.
- **2010-10-B026** - Alliance Grain Terminal (AGT). Golder Associates is proposing to drill 11 boreholes within the AGT waterlot. Recd by BERC Oct 12/10.
- **2010-10-B027** - VFPA to construct a women's washroom within an existing janitorial closet, and adjacent to an existing men's washroom, on the 4K level at Canada Place. Recd by BERC Oct 26/10.
- **2010-10-B028** – Chevron is proposing an Archaeological Impact Assessment (AIA) of the Foreshore Interim Mitigation Strategy that BERC is currently reviewing as a Track 2 project. Recd by ERC Oct 26/10.
- **2010-11-B029** - Seaspan International Ltd. (Seaspan) proposes to contract Vancouver Pile Driving (VPD) to replace a total of 20 damaged timber piles at its dock and barge berth located in Burrard Inlet adjacent to 10 Pemberton Avenue, North Vancouver, BC. Recd by ERC Nov 9/10. Authorisation issued Nov 15/10. Nov 17/10 - NWP approval to be issued.
- **2010-11-B030** - application to conduct slope stabilization, grading and outfall reestablishment works in the Old West Trestle Area of the Viterra facility located in Vancouver, BC. Recd by BERC Nov 15/10. Proponent proposes to use tracer dye to find outfall exit, VFPA requesting MSDS.
- **2010-12-B032** Arcadis Canada Inc., on behalf of Kinder Morgan Canada Terminals, is proposing to conduct a sediment sampling program in support of an upcoming maintenance dredging application for the Vancouver Wharves North Shore facility. Recd by BERC Dec 1/10.
- **2010-12- B033** - URS Canada Inc., on behalf of Chevron Canada Ltd., proposes to conduct a detailed site investigation (DSI) on the foreshore north of the Chevron Refinery located at 5201 Penzance Drive, Burnaby, BC. Recd by BERC Dec 9/10.
- **2010-12-B034** - SLR Consulting Ltd., on behalf of Domtar Inc., proposes to conduct geotechnical drilling at six locations in the rip rap/intertidal area near the Syncrolift at the Vancouver Shipyards, Pemberton Avenue, North Vancouver, BC. Recd by BERC Dec 17/10.
- **2012-12-B035** - Vancouver Pile Driving Ltd., on behalf of Gayle Goodrich, proposes to install two timber piles and a timber pile cap in the residential water lot adjacent to 4781 Strathcona Road, North Vancouver, BC. Recd by BERC Dec 18/10.
